

## Choosing the best way to pay

After your initial consultation you will be given a written estimate of the cost of any treatment which may be necessary.

Our normal practice policy is for payment to be made before the start of treatment.

Payment may be made in cash cheque debit card.

**Remember** if you are:

- under 18
- under 19 in full time education
- pregnant, or have had a baby in the past year
- in receipt of certain state benefits

**you may be entitled to free dental treatment.**

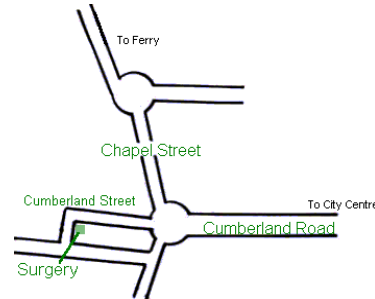
If you think you may qualify for free treatment, please ask.

## Keeping your appointments:

If you fail to attend an appointment or cancel within 24 hours of your appointment, you will receive a marker. Two markers may result in no further appointments at the practice.

To prevent this happening, we ask you to give us at least 24 hours notice if you wish to cancel an appointment, so that we can use the surgery time efficiently.
